HUNGER TASK FORCE COLLECTS RECORD-SETTING 75,000 POUNDS OF FOOD DURING THURSDAY’S “STOP HUNGER DAY” AT SUMMERFEST

Milwaukee (June 28, 2007)—Hunger Task Force collected a record-setting 75,000 pounds of food during Stop Hunger Day at Summerfest, Thursday, June 28. **The 75,000 pounds of food is the largest amount Hunger Task Force has ever collected at Summerfest, surpassing 63,000 pounds collected in 2006.**

Stop Hunger Day was sponsored by Fresh Brands’ Piggly Wiggly stores, which graciously provided free admission to all Summerfest patrons who donated three or more items of nonperishable food.

The food was collected in three hours. Hunger Task Force will deliver all food to the hungry free of charge.
