

Hunger Task Force Position Description Delivery Driver/Route Representative

General Function

The Delivery Driver loads, transports and unloads food orders to local and regional distribution sites. Works closely with site staff and community volunteers; creates receipts and maintains delivery documentation; adheres to all safety protocols.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Provide excellent quality client and internal/external customer service.
- Represent the agency in a positive manner.
- Load, transport, and deliver food to sites per established routes and schedules.
- Monitor storage and distribution at program sites. Verify amounts received/issued are been properly recorded.
- Ensure that all food is handled and stored safely.
- Inventory Management: Must be able to operate scanning/bar codes equipment so that pallets can be properly identified into the perpetual inventory system. Maintain established inventory controls.
- Load/unload commercial trailers: Unload product. Must be able to properly place pallets to avoid damage.
- Builds and palletizes food orders as directed.
- Assist in maintaining a clean and orderly warehouse.
- Document services rendered by completing necessary paperwork and maintaining a delivery log.
- Operate vehicles and agency equipment safely. Maintain equipment and vehicles.
- Support volunteer staff at assigned sites.
- Perform other duties as needed

Certificates, Licenses, Registrations

Valid Driver's License required. Forklift Certification preferred. CDL preferred. Successful candidates can receive forklift certification through on the job training.

Supervisory Responsibilities

Associate degree or equivalent from two-year college or technical school; or six months to one year related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Competencies

Quality Management - Looks for ways to improve and promote quality; Demonstrates accuracy and thoroughness.

Ethics - Treats people with respect; Keeps commitments; inspires the trust of others; Works with integrity and ethically; Upholds organizational values.

Organizational Support - Follows policies and procedures; Completes administrative tasks correctly and on time; supports organization's goals and values; Benefits organization through outside activities; Supports affirmative action and respects diversity.

Dependability - Follows instructions, responds to management direction; Takes responsibility for own actions; Keeps commitments; Commits to long hours of work when necessary to reach goals.; Completes tasks on time or notifies appropriate person with an alternate plan.

Initiative - Volunteers readily; Undertakes self-development activities; Seeks increased responsibilities; Takes independent actions and calculated risks; Looks for and takes advantage of opportunities; Asks for and offers help when needed.

Qualifications

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. Language Skills

Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals. Ability to write routine reports and correspondence. Ability to speak effectively before groups of customers or employees of organization.

Mathematical Skills

Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals. Ability to compute rate, ratio, and percent and to draw and interpret bar graphs.

Reasoning Ability

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form. Ability to deal with problems involving several concrete variables in standardized situations

Computer Skills

To perform this job successfully, an individual should have knowledge of Database software; Inventory software; Spreadsheet software and Word Processing software.

Other Skills and Abilities

Ability to work well with Senior Citizens. Bilingual (Spanish or Russian) preferred.

Other Qualifications

Knowledge of standards of safe food handling, storage & distribution. Knowledge of occupational and safety standards. Knowledge of highways and roads of Milwaukee County.

Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this Job, the employee is regularly required to stand; walk and use hands to finger, handle, or feel.
