


### What is FoodShare?

- This federally funded program enables hundreds of thousands of low-income adults, children, and seniors throughout the state with funds to purchase groceries.

## Who Uses FoodShare in Wisconsin?\*









**48%** of families have at least one member who is elderly, blind or has disabilities.





#### **Economic Growtl**

Percentage of Poverty






## **Burnett County Poverty**

- Burnett has a high level of poverty (13.6%), ranking it 55th out of 72 counties.
- Burnett has a high level of child poverty (21.4%), ranking it 62nd out of 72 counties.
- Burnett has a moderate senior poverty (7.4%), ranking it 27th out of 72 counties.
