


What is FoodShare?

Who Uses FoodShare in Wisconsin?*









48% of families have at least one member who is elderly, blind or has disabilities.







For every \$1 in FoodShare benefits an additional **51.70** is used in the **local** economy.

Percentage of Poverty






Waupaca County Poverty
