

- This federally funded program enables hundreds of thousands of low-income adults, children, and seniors throughout the state with funds to purchase groceries.

## Who Uses FoodShare in Wisconsin?\*









**42%** of recipients are children.





#### **Economic Growt**

Percentage of Poverty






## **Waushara County Poverty**

- Waushara has a moderate level of poverty (11.3%), ranking it 35th out of 72 counties.
