

- This federally funded program enables hundreds of thousands of low-income adults, children, and seniors throughout the state with funds to purchase groceries.

Who Uses FoodShare in Wisconsin?*









42% of recipients are children.






Percentage of Poverty






Marquette County Poverty

- Marquette has a moderate level of poverty (11.4%), ranking it 36th out of 72 counties.
- Marquette has a moderate level of child poverty (15.7%), ranking it 42nd out of 72 counties.
- Marguette has a moderate level of senior poverty (8.1%), ranking it 45th out of 72 counties.
