What is FoodShare?


- ← FoodShare is the name of the Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program (SNAP) in Wisconsin.

children.




48% of ramilies nave at least one member who is elderly, blind or has disabilities.





Wisconsin Poverty by County






Richland County Poverty
