


Food for Families History

THE FIRST EVER FOOD FOR FAMILIES CAMPAIGN WAS LAUNCHED MORE THAN 40 YEARS AGO.


It was a year of economic recession with great community need. Food was collected in barrels across the community and Hunger Task Force took its first steps as a food bank to distribute the food to emergency pantries.
