

Get Help Buying Groceries for Your Children!



What is Pandemic EBT?

Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) is a program that provides grocery benefits to parents to replace the value of missed school meals.

If you're a FoodShare household with children under 6, you qualify for another type of P-EBT. See back for details.

Am I Eligible?

Your family qualifies for P-EBT if:

- Your child attended school virtually at any point during the 2020-21 school year AND
- Your child has been eligible for free or reduced-price meals* in the 2019-20 OR 2020-21 school year

** Your child's school must participate in the National School Lunch Program. Unsure? Call your school to confirm.*

How Much Will My Family Receive and When?

The benefit amount will depend on how much of the school year your children spent learning virtually versus in-person, as well as if they are eligible for the school-aged or Under 6 P-EBT program.

How Do I Receive My Pandemic EBT Benefits?



Did You Receive a Letter in the Mail from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) Regarding Pandemic EBT?

YES

And my information is correct

You do not need to take any action. You will receive your P-EBT benefits based on the issuance schedule.

If you do not receive your benefits, you should contact DHS to discuss your case. Send an email to PEBTsupport@wisconsin.gov or call 833-431-2224.

YES

But my information is NOT correct

You should contact DHS to discuss your case. Send an email to PEBTsupport@wisconsin.gov or call 833-431-2224.

YES

But it says I am eligible for \$0

You should contact DHS to discuss your case. Send an email to PEBTsupport@wisconsin.gov or call 833-431-2224.

NO

I did NOT receive a notice in the mail

If you didn't receive anything in the mail but believe your child is eligible for P-EBT, you should apply for P-EBT online.



Apply for P-EBT today at <https://access.wi.gov/pebt>.

** **Important:** The application has a space for a Social Security Number. **A Social Security Number is NOT required to apply for and receive P-EBT.** The immigration status of neither parent nor child is relevant to their ability to receive Pandemic EBT.*

Under 6 Pandemic EBT



P-EBT benefits have also been approved for non-school-aged children! Your family qualifies for this benefit if:

- Your children were under age 6 as of Oct. 1, 2020
- and
- Your children were part of an active FoodShare household



You do not need to take action. P-EBT benefits will be added to your existing QUEST card.
