# Get Help Buying Groceries for Your Children!



## Nearly 70,000 Wisconsin students are still missing out on Pandemic EBT. Is your child one of them?

Pandemic EBT provides several issuances of grocery benefits to replace the value of missed meals for kids. These benefits are added directly to a QUEST card or Pandemic EBT debit card that can be used to purchase groceries.

### What is Pandemic EBT?

Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) is a program that provides grocery benefits to parents to replace the value of missed school meals.

There are other kinds of Pandemic EBT available. See the back of this flyer to learn more about Summer EBT and Under 6 P-EBT for your children.

### Am I Eligible?

Your family qualifies for P-EBT if:

- Your child attended school virtually at any point during the 2020-21 school year **AND**
- Your child has been eligible for free or reduced-price meals\* in the 2019-20 OR 2020-21 school year

\* Your child's school must participate in the National School Lunch Program. Unsure? Call your school to confirm.

### How Much Will My Family Receive and When?

The benefit amount will depend on how much of the school year your children spent learning virtually versus in-person, as well as if they are eligible for the school-aged or Under 6 P-EBT program.

# How Do I Receive My Pandemic EBT Benefits?

## Under 6 Pandemic EBT



Pandemic-EBT benefits are approved for non-school-aged children! Your family qualifies for this benefit if:

- Your children were under age 6 as of Oct. 1, 2020

**AND**

- Your children were part of an active FoodShare household



You do not need to take action. P-EBT benefits will be added to your existing QUEST card.

The maximum amount a family could receive for Under 6 P-EBT would be \$1,027 per eligible child.

## Summer Pandemic EBT



Summer P-EBT provides Change highlighted to a one-time \$375 benefit, regardless of virtual learning status.

All children who received either School-Aged or Under 6 P-EBT should receive Summer EBT. Your family qualifies for this benefit if:

- Your children received School-Aged or Under 6 P-EBT

**OR**

- Your children were enrolled in free or reduced-price meals in the 2020-21 school year (or they apply for free and reduced-price meals through their school by Sept. 1)

Summer P-EBT benefits will be added to your QUEST card, existing white Pandemic EBT card or you will receive a new Pandemic EBT card in the mail.
