What is Pandemic EBT?

Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) is a program that provides grocery benefits to parents to replace the value of missed school meals.

Am I Eligible?

Your family qualifies for P-EBT if your child attended school virtually or had a COVID-related absence during the 2021-22 school year.

** Your child's school must participate in the National School Lunch Program. Unsure? Call your school to confirm.*

How Much Will My Family Receive and When?

The benefit amount will depend on how much of the school year your child spent learning virtually versus in-person. Benefits are calculated by the Department of Health Services based on each day of virtual learning or due to a COVID-related absence during the 2021-22 school year AND your child was enrolled in free or reduced-priced meals at the time of absence.

Benefits will be issued for specific months of the school year as outlined below.

Benefit Issue Date	Months Covered
Early March	Aug, Sept, & October
Early April	November & December
Mid-May	January & February
Mid-June	March & April
Late July	May & June

If your school-aged child has not had any days of virtual learning or closures due to COVID-19, your child is **NOT** eligible for Pandemic EBT benefits.

You do not need to take any action.



Your P-EBT benefits will be added to your existing QUEST Card.

Apply for FoodShare at www.access.wi.gov
Households of four currently receive up to \$782 a month to buy groceries. FoodShare households are **automatically eligible** for P-EBT benefits!




If you are NOT eligible for FoodShare, you MAY STILL BE ELIGIBLE for Pandemic EBT.
Contact your school and apply for free or reduced-price school meals.

Is Your Child Eligible to Recieve Free or Reduced-Priced Meals at School?

You do not need to take any action.



You will recieve a white P-EBT debit card in the mail. If you have a previous P-EBT card, your benefits will be added to it.

Your child may still be eligible for free or reduced-price meals.
Contact your school to apply.

*In order to qualify for P-EBT, your child must attend a school that participates in the National School Lunch Program or the School Breakfast Program. If you do not know if that is the case, you can check the list of schools that participate in these programs at: <https://bit.ly/wi-nslp>
